The Vista del Mar MAKO Educational Foundation is hosting the 4<sup>th</sup> Annual MAKO Masters on **Friday, February 21st, 2020** at the Talega Golf Club. The MAKO Masters is the foundation's premier fundraising and networking event. The 4<sup>th</sup> Annual MAKO Masters will feature a golf tournament, a helicopter golf ball drop, an online auction, and a social hour with an awards ceremony. The event, which sold out last year, draws participants from the approximately 1,200 families that have children attending Vista del Mar Elementary and Middle Schools. Businesses that donate to the event will be given marketing exposure to these families and showcased as supporters of Vista del Mar students.

Established in 2005, the MAKO Foundation is a volunteer-led, non-profit organization that raises funds for programs designed to enhance the education, safety and general welfare of the students of Vista del Mar Elementary and Middle schools. In the last four years the MAKO Foundation has deployed over \$700,000 back into the schools. Without the foundation's significant contribution (and the contributions of our PTA) our students would not go on fieldtrips, have a librarian, art and music programs, or access to individual computers in the classroom. They would not have an advanced technology lab, a robotics program, or the elevated safety that comes with an electronic signin system for campus visitors and a campus wide security camera system. And our teacher's would not have received the advanced writing training that has translated into improved writing test scores for our students.
